

Ku-ring-gai Hockey Centre (KHC) – User Guidelines

Renewal Project – Over 2023-24 KHC has undergone a major renewal. The National-rated field has been completely re-established and a contemporary dry surface has been installed. New LED lighting provides an illumination quality suitable for television, new pitch-side dugouts include area dedicated to match Officials and work is ongoing to upgrade the amenity building.

Location – KHC is located within the grounds of the Ku-ring-gai High School @ 403 Bobbin Head Rd, North Turramurra NSW 2074.



Car Parking – Parking is available either within the designated teachers gravel car-park shown above OR on the verges of Bobbin Head Road. The car-park entrance from Bobbin Head Road is TWO-way, so please beware of vehicles exiting.

Even if the main gates to the school are open, **KHC User vehicles are NOT allowed to enter the school grounds or to park within other staff car-parks on school grounds.**

Pedestrian Access to the KHC Field – See the picture above for the designated pedestrian access corridor marked in **BLUE**. Please stay to this access corridor only. **KHC Users are NOT allowed to stray into the wider precinct of the school.**

Player, coach and officials access to and exit from the KHC playing field is via the gates on the amenities building side of the pitch OR the double-gates at the southern end of the pitch.

First Aid @ KHC – A defibrillator is located in the pitch-side Officials room at the player dug-outs. A first aid room will be available at the amenity block once construction works are complete.

Emergency vehicle access – In the event of medical or other emergency, emergency services have a specific emergency access key allowing them to unlock the main school entrance gates. Access is then provided through the school grounds, via the basketball courts and grass field directly towards the hockey field as indicated below.



Amenity building – The amenity building at KHC will be under renovation until at least mid-April 2024. Until works are complete, the amenity building will be fenced to protect persons from the ongoing construction activity. We ask that **KHC users shall NOT enter the construction zone please.**

Canteen – The canteen at the amenity building will be closed until construction works are completed, but subsequently will be operated by Gordon North Sydney Hockey Club (GNS) and open most days when GNS teams are playing at KHC. Alcohol is not available at the canteen, but a good range of refreshments, coffee and drinks are usually stocked.

General Information

- No dogs and no smoking on school grounds
- Temporary portable toilets have been installed at the southern end of the pitch for KHC users while the amenity building is closed for redevelopment.
- Please ensure facility is left, hopefully as you found it, clean and ready for the next user.
- Please respect other customers by adhering to your booking times. This may require you to warm-up off the turf to enable another party to finish and you will be required to leave the turf at the end of your booking time if another customer is waiting.
